It is proposed to hold the groups annual exhibition in Manchester on Wednesday 3rd November 2010. The event will launch the revised and updated Guide D publication.

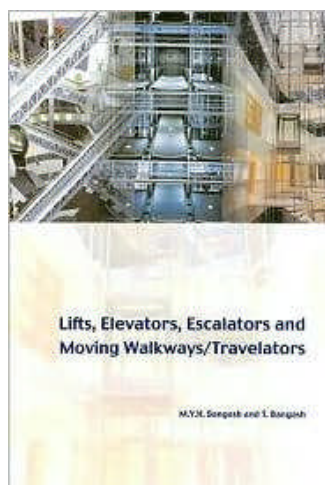
7.0 CIBSE Lift Group Hong Kong
